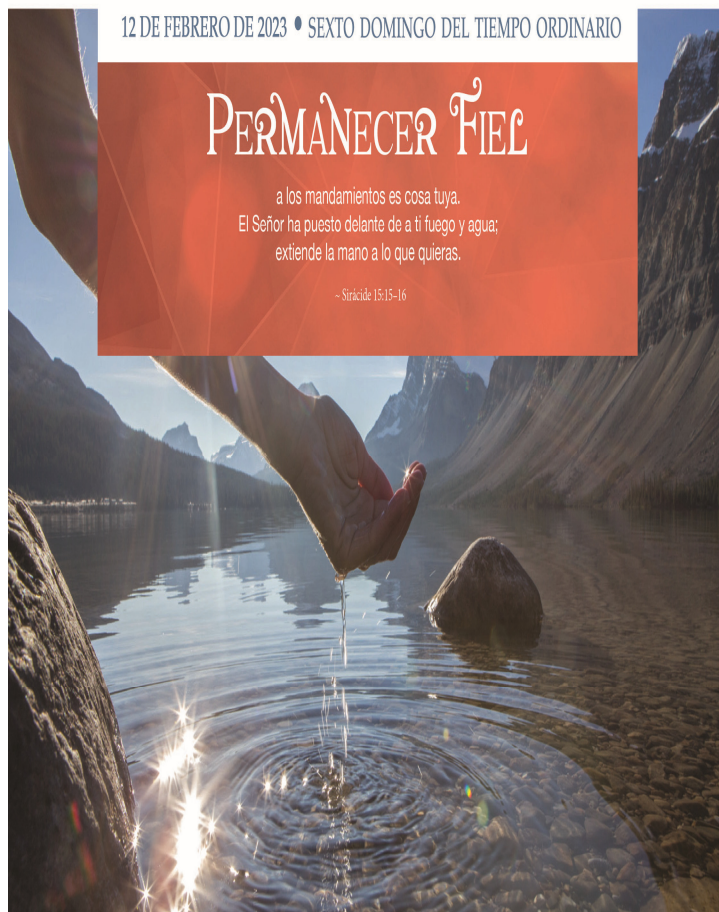

From the Pastor's Pen

From the very beginning of *All Things New* we have been asking the question "Which communities does it make most sense to have come together in light of demographic shifts, evangelization and social outreach efforts, resources, and priest availability?"

You shared your feedback on what our parishes, ministries, and institutions need to look like to effectively share the faith in a way that is suitable and sustainable for our children, grandchildren, and generations to come.

Using the parish feedback summaries, parish workbooks and financial data of every parish in the Archdiocese, the *All Things New* planning committee has refined the first draft models to a second set of draft models, which offer one draft model per planning area.

- The second draft models for all 15 planning areas are now available for review on allthingsnew.archstl.org.
- Because of your feedback, of the 42 first draft models initially presented to priests, deacons, religious, parish life coordinators, key archdiocesan advisory bodies, and the lay faithful for consideration, none were adopted in the second draft models.
- The models show the Archdiocese being reshaped from 178 individual parish pastorates into 88 pastorates in order to best serve the lay faithful. A pastorate is a community that is under the pastoral care of one pastor and pastoral team.
- Please provide any feedback you have about the second draft models to your pastor or key parish leaders by Wednesday, February 15.
- This will be the last set of draft models and the final portion of feedback gathered in order to enable Archbishop Rozanski to make a well-informed, discerned decision for the spiritual well-being of the Archdiocese, looking at the feedback of the people and the needs of the Archdiocese. This decision will be announced on May 28, 2023 by Archbishop Rozanski.

De la Pluma del Padre

Desde el comienzo de *All Things New*, hemos estado haciendo la pregunta "¿Qué comunidades tiene más sentido que se hayan unido a la luz de los cambios demográficos, los esfuerzos de evangelización y alcance social, los recursos y la disponibilidad de sacerdotes?"

Usted compartió sus comentarios sobre cómo deben verse nuestras parroquias, ministerios e instituciones para compartir la fe de manera efectiva de una manera que sea adecuada y sostenible para nuestros hijos, nietos y generaciones venideras.

Utilizando los resúmenes de comentarios parroquiales, los libros de trabajo parroquiales y los datos financieros de cada parroquia de la Arquidiócesis, el comité de planificación *All Things New* ha refinado los primeros modelos preliminares a un segundo conjunto de modelos preliminares, que ofrecen un modelo preliminar por área de planificación.

- El segundo borrador de los modelos para las 15 áreas de planificación ya está disponible para su revisión en allthingsnew.archstl.org.
- Debido a sus comentarios, de los 42 primeros borradores de modelos presentados inicialmente a sacerdotes, diáconos, religiosos, coordinadores de vida parroquial, órganos consultivos clave de la arquidiócesis y fieles laicos para su consideración, ninguno fue adoptado en el segundo borrador de modelos.
- Los modelos muestran que la Arquidiócesis se está remodelando de 178 párrocos parroquiales individuales a 88 párrocos para servir mejor a los fieles laicos. Un pastorado es una comunidad que está bajo el cuidado pastoral de un pastor y un equipo pastoral.
- Proporcione cualquier comentario que tenga sobre los modelos del segundo borrador a su párroco o líderes parroquiales clave antes del miércoles 15 de febrero.
- Este será el último conjunto de borradores de modelos y la parte final de los comentarios recopilados para permitir que el Arzobispo Rozanski tome una decisión discernida y bien informada para el bienestar espiritual de la Arquidiócesis, considerando los comentarios de la gente y las necesidades de la Arquidiócesis. Esta decisión será anunciada el 28 de mayo de 2023 por el arzobispo Rozanski.

THE GLORY OF THE DIVINE WAY

Today's readings draw us into ageless, vibrant depths. Followers of God's law, we belong to ancient traditions. Children of God, we marvel at the freshness of creation. The Old Testament readings, from Sirach and the Psalms, celebrate the rich blessings we receive when we observe God's commands—not because we are slaves to the law, but because the law gives life in abundance. Saint Paul's Letter to the Corinthians confirms the glory of divine law, but warns that God's ways tend to be unpopular and misunderstood in this world. Paul speaks of the ancient wisdom of God, which is mysteriously both "hidden" and "revealed." God does not have secret codes that we earthly mortals cannot understand; in love, God reveals the glory of the divine way in Jesus. Saint Matthew's Gospel emphasizes the importance of living in God's law, enlivened by a deep and personal relationship with Jesus.

El Evangelio de san Mateo subraya la importancia de vivir en la ley de Dios, animada por una relación profunda y personal con Jesús.

OUR FASCINATING FAITH

The Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order

On February 17 we honor the seven founding saints of the Order of the Servants of the Virgin Mary. Bonfilius, Alexis, Manettus, Amideus, Hugh, Sostene and Buonagiunta were a group of merchants of Florence who, upon experiencing an apparition of the Blessed Virgin in 1233, renounced their businesses, left what was necessary for their families, and distributed the rest among the poor. They then dedicated themselves entirely to the veneration of the Virgin Mary, going to live on an Italian mountain, each assuming the life of a hermit—prayer, extreme fasting and penance. Sometime later, at the request of the pope's delegate, all but one were ordained priests. Brother Alexis, considering himself unworthy of the priesthood, decided to remain as a brother. They were all canonized in 1888. Their feast day, originally February 11, now falls on the 17th, the date of the death of the last of the seven founders. Brother Alexis died at the age of 110.

NUESTRA FASCINANTE FE

Los siete santos fundadores de la Orden de los Siervos

El 17 de febrero honramos a los siete santos fundadores de la Orden de los Siervos de la Virgen María. Bonfilius, Alexis, Manettus, Amideus, Hugh, Sostene y Buonagiunta eran un grupo de comerciantes de Florencia que, al experimentar una aparición de la Santísima Virgen en 1233, renunciaron a sus negocios, dejaron lo necesario para sus familias y distribuyeron el resto entre los pobres. Luego se dedicaron por completo a la veneración de la Virgen María, yendo a vivir a una montaña italiana, asumiendo cada uno la vida de un ermitaño: oración, ayuno extremo y penitencia. Tiempo después, a petición del delegado del Papa, todos menos uno fueron ordenados sacerdotes. El hermano Alexis, considerándose indigno del sacerdocio, decidió permanecer como hermano. Todos fueron canonizados en 1888. Su fiesta, originalmente el 11 de febrero, cae ahora el 17, fecha de la muerte del último de los siete fundadores. El Hermano Alexis murió a la edad de 110 años.

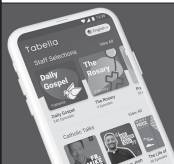
